

Michigan VOTERS AGREE: FAMILIES WANT PUBLIC SCHOOL OPTIONS

STRONG, BIPARTISAN SUPPORT FOR CHARTER SCHOOLS AND STUDENT-CENTERED FUNDING.

76% of Michigan voters support public school choice

63% of Michiganders support charter schools with strong support across political parties

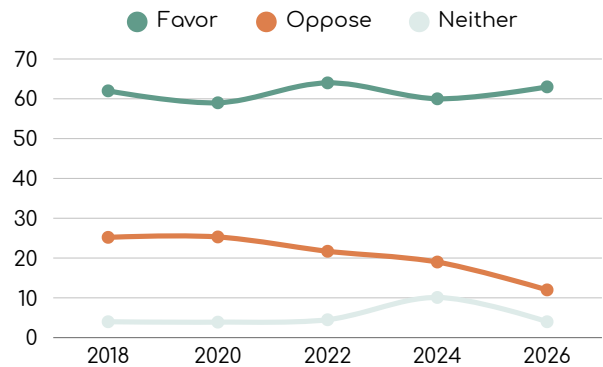
61% of Michiganders want charter schools available to more students

46% of Michiganders are more likely to support pro-charter candidates reflecting a significant shift in voter priorities

Support is Strong—and Growing

Voter support for school choice and charter schools has remained high and continues to trend upward across Michigan, while total opposition continues to decline. With key demographic shifts:

- Democrats: 49.5% → ****59%**** (+9.5 pts)
- Republicans: 61.2% → ****75%**** (+13.8 pts)
- African Americans: 43.2% → ****60%**** (+16.8 pts)
